- 5.30pm at the Exhibition Bar: **the Golden Bus Awards**, which honours the best European bus driver.

Jeudi 12 juin

- 11.30am in the Alternative Mode zone: **Signature of the Charter of bike-sharing towns.**
- 3.30pm at the "Carrefour de l'Europe": **The Public Transport Innovation Awards** with Dominique Bussereau, the French Secretary of State in charge of Transport.

Not to be missed during the three-day exhibition

- **The European Pavilion** brings together Carris (the Lisbon network) and the STIB-MIVB (the Brussels network).
- **The Exhibitor Platform**, where exhibitors will have the floor to introduce their latest innovations and strategies.

- **400sqm of space devoted to alternative mode transport** and promoting alternative travel solutions (cycling, car-pooling and so on).
